

National 9-1-1 Office to Host Webinars on ENHANCE 9-1-1 Grants

WASHINGTON D.C. – The national 9-1-1 Implementation Coordination Office (National 9-1-1 Office) will host a series of webinars on the ENHANCE 9-1-1 Act and the Final Grant Regulations published June 5, 2009. The webinars will be led by staff of the National 9-1-1 Office and the 9-1-1 Technical Assistance Center (currently being established by the National 9-1-1 Office).

The 9-1-1 Grant Program published final regulations in the Federal Register on June 5, 2009. The webinar will provide potential grant applicants with the information they need to apply for the grant by providing specific instructions and information from the final regulation. The webinar will cover a review of the ENHANCE 9-1-1 Act, an overview of the 9-1-1 Grant Program, the rules and regulations, grant application requirements, eligible uses for the grant, as well as a summary of the grant information packet. At the conclusion of the webinar, time will be allotted for a question and answer session.
